Main points that were agreed at the GFX testing workshop.

Cost of integration on developers

Developers need to own the test suites and CI infrastructure: Main instance has to be community-owned.

Make the CI results hard to ignore by integrating in the development workflow.

Enforce through social norm.

Create an open source CI toolbox

Let people define their workflows, and chose their components, but we need to define interfaces!

Allow external runners

Allow HW-specific test farms to plug into the infrastructure and push results there.

Need to be approved by the project being tested.

Allow these farms to run their own private tests too.
